



Welcome to Esk Hall

Esk Hall is a majestic Georgian mansion house steeped in local history. Nestling at the foot of the Esk Valley and overlooking the winding River Esk, it's surrounded by manicured gardens where a recent-added folly takes pride of place.

Esk Hall is a truly beautiful house with many original features – there is a beautiful carved wooden fireplace and ceiling cornices. It has been totally refurbished to a very high standard, re-building the West Wing and the conservatory providing wonderful and panoramic views over Esk Valley and the North Yorkshire Moors Railway. The East Wing has been restored to its former glory after being demolished in the 1950's.



Esk Hall was built circa 1700 with Whitby Herringbone Sandstone; it is a Grade 11 listed Georgian Country House, set in 5 acres of landscaped gardens and paddock. The Esk steam train and river run along the edge of the grounds.

The house has 16 en-suite bedrooms, two double suites; four of the bedrooms benefiting from tiled wet rooms. Two suites have been converted on the second floor providing spacious and most comfortable accommodation, again with views over Esk Valley. There are two further house bathrooms and a large ground-floor wet room. We also have a spacious dining room, a light, luxurious yet comfortable lounge with panoramic windows giving views of the valley, which leads into our breath-taking conservatory. The elegant hallway is still the same layout as it was originally, retaining all its elegance and charm.

Esk Hall Care Home can be found in the picturesque village of Slights, which lies approximately to the south west of Whitby and benefits from direct access via the A174, A171 and A169 with the latter continuing through the village to the market town of Pickering. Esk Hall is close to Goathland, home to Heartbeat and the North York Moors, providing many places to visit and enjoy.



The gardens allow the residents to enjoy the sun in pleasant surroundings and there is an opportunity for them to walk around the village.

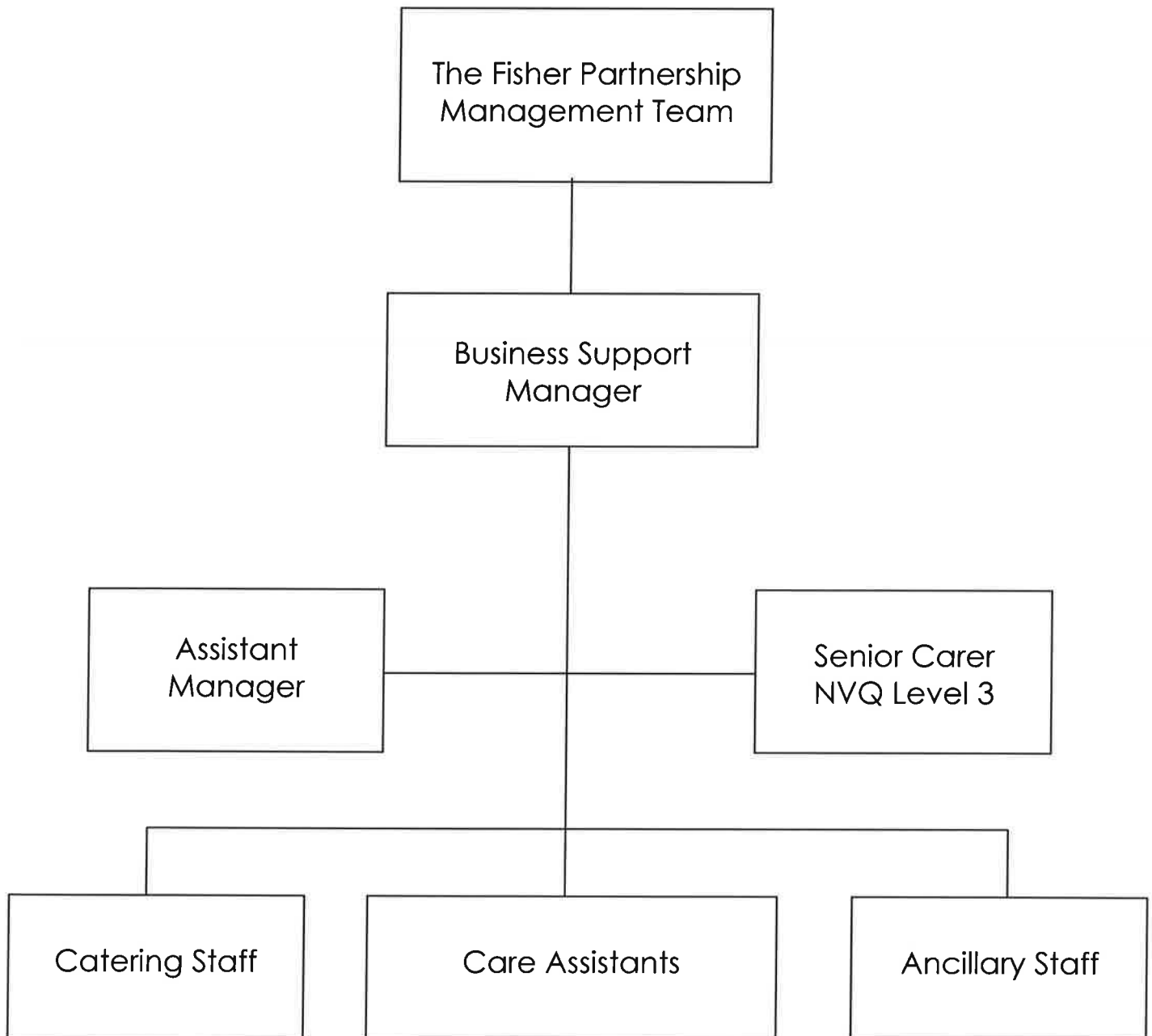

Service User Guide

Summary of Purpose of the Home

Esk Hall is owned by Esk Hall Limited, which has its main office at 10 North Park Road, Harrogate, HG1 5PG. The owners also manage and own other care homes in North Yorkshire.

Esk Hall opened in 1990, to enable our residents to continue living as independently as possible by receiving care and support consistent with their incapacities and disabilities.

We continue to value each and every individual, who comes to live at Esk Hall. We welcome applications from people from all walks of life and with many different needs, who enjoy the opportunity to share and celebrate the richness and diversity of their experience. All residents are assured that they will be treated with respect and dignity according to their individual needs and wishes.

People who enquire about our accommodation and services are provided with our brochure. All inquirers are made aware of our diversity and anti-discriminatory policies and are encouraged to visit the Home before continuing with their application. They may then apply directly for residence at Esk Hall; all applicants are subject to an assessment of their needs and also an assessment of their financial circumstances.

Each application is given careful consideration by the Home's management and, depending on vacancies, a decision to offer residency is made within seven days. Where there is no current vacancy it is possible for an applicant to be placed on a waiting list.

Number of Places and for Whom

Esk Hall is a registered care home, and aims to provide high-standard accommodation and care for 20 residents. All accommodation complies with the National Minimum Standards that came into force from 1 April 2002, being equipped with en suite facilities, some having bathroom suites and others shower rooms.

Anyone over the age of 65 years, including married couples or partners, who because of physical or mental incapacities require help with daily living, is entitled to apply for residency at Esk Hall.

We operate a strong diversity policy in respect of residents and staff, and are committed to ensuring that no-one is excluded on the grounds of their ethnicity, religion or culture. We therefore discuss with each applicant how their individual and cultural needs can be met.
